# VISALIA ROTARY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Meeting called to order at 7:00 a.m. by President Susan Lucas.

A quorum is 33 1/3% of the fifteen-member voting Board which equals five directors; this meeting had **nine** votes in the form of **eleven** directors toward a quorum. A majority vote shall be sufficient to constitute action by the Board of Directors. When a director holds more than one directorship each directorship counts toward a quorum, but the director has only one vote.

MINUTES: The minutes of the April 25, 2023, meeting stand as presented.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Presented by Gary Simmons; Financial report - The total balance in all the accounts was \$6,316,193.24 as of May 18, 2023, compared to the balance of \$6,334,338.54 as of April 20, 2023. There were no disbursements this month. The Blarney Bash – Income \$15,166 Expenses \$9,841 for profit of \$5,325.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

A.) Scholarship Committee – Susan Lucas. The Scholarship Committee interviewed eight students for the Dwelle Scholarship and it was awarded to Madison Andrade. There was a question asked by a student that qualified for a

scholarship, this student would like to know when the scholarship money would be paid out? Susan Luscas stated that before the money would be paid, they had to submit their class schedule and their transcripts prior to distribution and normally that does not happen until the fall.

Susan stated that is all she has for scholarships for now and at this time the Director of Scholarships will be passed onto Liz Wynn and Anees Akhund. Most of it is well organized for the transfer.

- B.) Grant Committee –Donn Ritter The committee met for the second time, with 18 applications received in the total requested amount of \$428,700 Donn stated that this was the largest amount ever requested. Out of the 18, one was immediately kicked out and Scott Jacobsen picked it up for the club he was in because it was for The Salvation Army and their request was for two \$500 scholarships. Partial requests were awarded to help with larger projects. An inquiry about donations where we had awarded amounts in conjunction with other donations for a large item, if this item had been fully funded or where they were at with the fund raising. There will be a letter sent for a six-month follow-up, so we know what happened. The budget was \$100,000 and the requests totaled \$109,500. Donn motioned that the additional funds be approved as it presented and was seconded by Eric Shannon. Motion passed. Donn wanted to thank the committee. Donn tried to obtain two members from every club to be on the Grant committee to make sure all clubs were represented.
- C.) Respite House –Deborah Volosin Deborah was unable to obtain the usage report prior to this meeting but will be reporting on it next month. Deborah also wanted to know what the board thought about the idea if one of the units is not being occupied if it would be possible to host some residents that are coming in for the months of June and July. Mr. Shannon spoke and stated that if one of them is kept for its intended use that using the other should be ok to use at this time. Deborah will report back on its usage.
