



Students who meet the President's Scholars criteria are reviewed for selection into the program. If selected, they are granted financial scholarships and unique support services to attend the College of the Sequoias.

Benefits

President's Scholars enjoy the following benefits/ opportunities while at the College of the Sequoias:

- Paid tuition for full-time student status for four semesters (not including summer)

SCHOLARS PROGRAM



Selection Criteria

Must have successfully submitted a COS Scholarship universal application by the deadline in December of your senior year. Go to: COS.edu/Scholarship

Must be a member, in good standing, of California Scholarship Federation (CSF) for four semesters of high school OR be CSF eligible for four semesters as verified by a high school counselor or principal.

Must be an in-state resident student.

Must have a high school GPA of at least 3.5 and no grade of "D" or below in 10th - 12th grades.

Must be a full-time student enrolled in a minimum of 12 units per semester at College of the Sequoias.

Student must be graduating from a California high school. (The scholarship is not available to out of state or international students).
